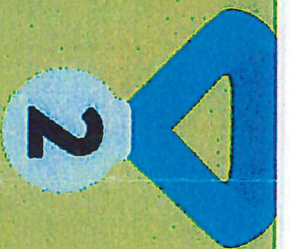


BRONZE

- Read a poem and review it with an adult or friend

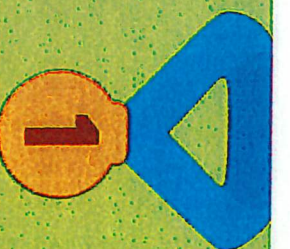


SILVER

Now you've achieved

Bronze, you are ready for the Silver award:

- Visit a library (other than the school library)
- Read a book that is set in a school
- Read 3 poems linked to a theme of your choice
- Research a topic of interest using a book
- Read a fiction book with a number in the title
- Visit a bookshop and take a 'shelfie'
- Design and recreate a front cover for a book of your choice
- Read a non-fiction book about a topic of interest



GOLD

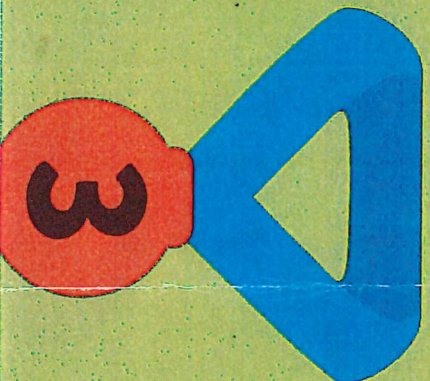
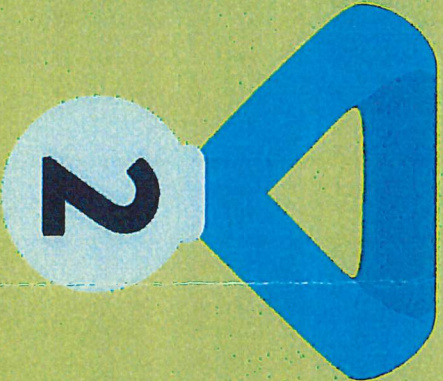
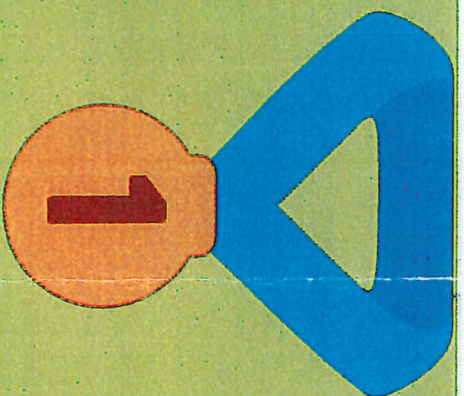
Now you've achieved Silver, you are now ready to go for

Gold:

- Share a book with a small group or whole class
- Choose a poem and recite it to a small group or whole class
- Design a promotional poster for reading
- Read a 'How to...' book e.g. a recipe and make the outcome
- Make a reading den and read in it
- Read a selection of at least 3 books by the same author and review your favourite one
- Help to care for the class reading corner for a half term
- Choose an author and email or write a letter to them about why you loved their book
- Create a book quiz for a friend or family member to complete
- Read at least 3 different genres; poetry, fiction, non-fiction, graphic novel
- Submit a book review for the library newsletter
- Have your reading record signed daily for half a term

NOTES

- For each medal the steps can be completed in any order
- We will need to see evidence that you have completed each step, for example, a photo of your reading den, the book from a library, a parent's signature or comment in your reading record to say they have read to you etc, the book/poem review you have written
- We can provide a book/poem review sheet for you to use
- For each award successfully achieved there will be a reward
