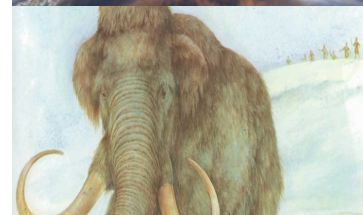
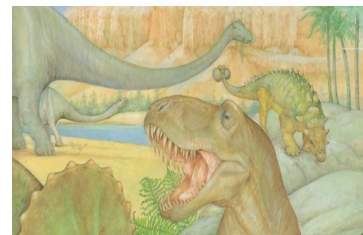


Year 1 History—Dinosaurs

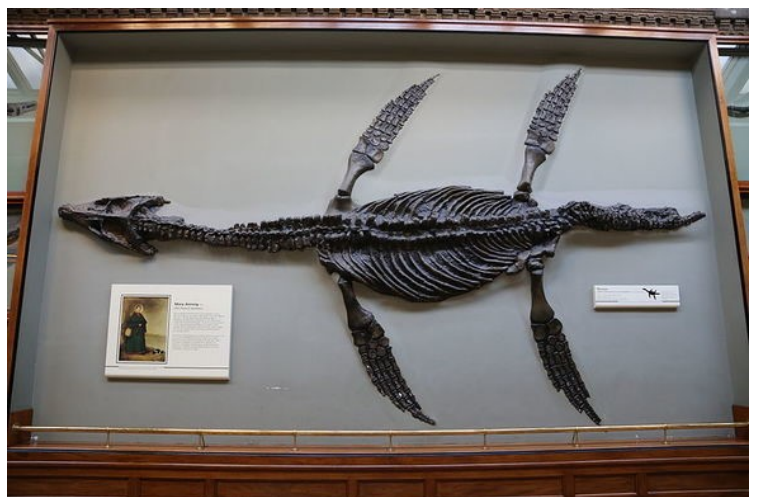
Timeline of our world
