herbivore

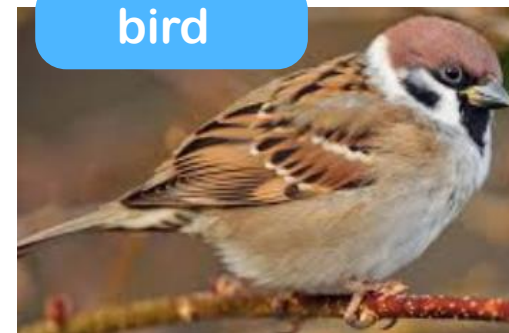
A plant eater.

omnivore

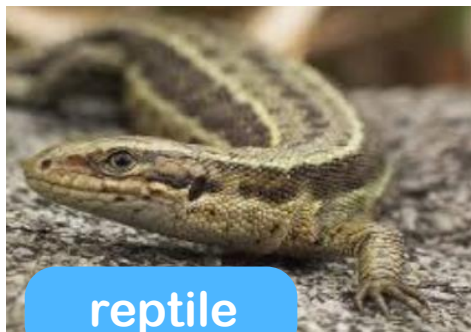
An animal that eats both meat and plants.

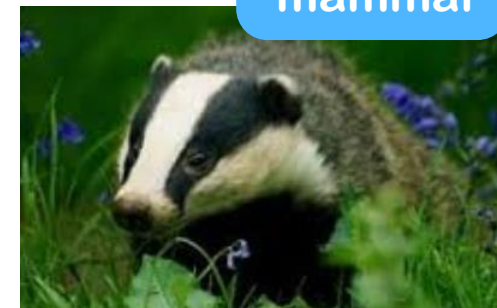

Under our skin is a skeleton made of bones.

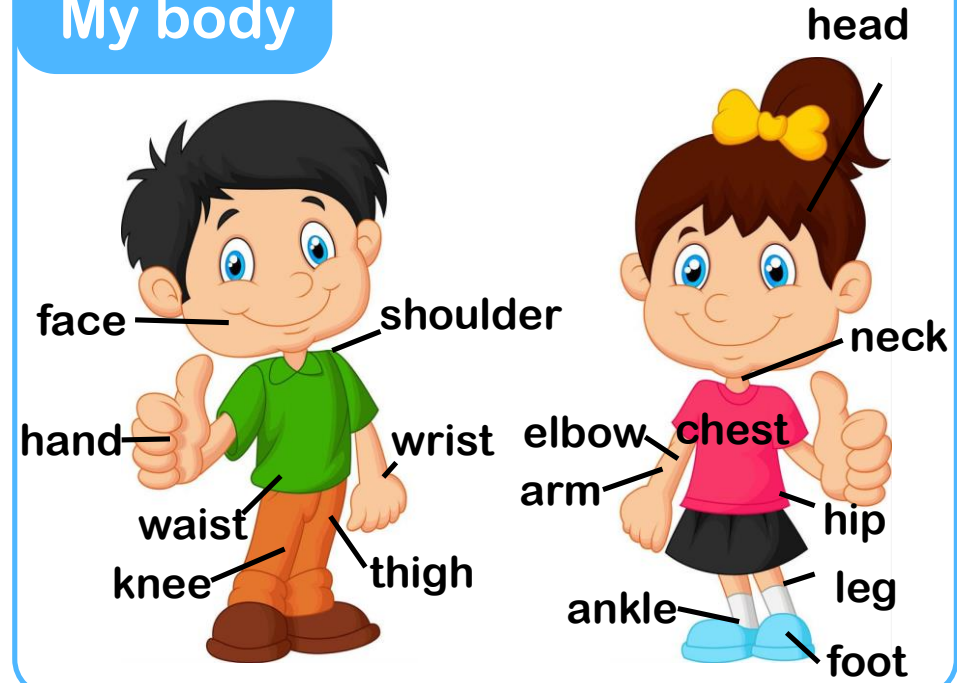
Just like other animals, we need to find food, water and shelter.
