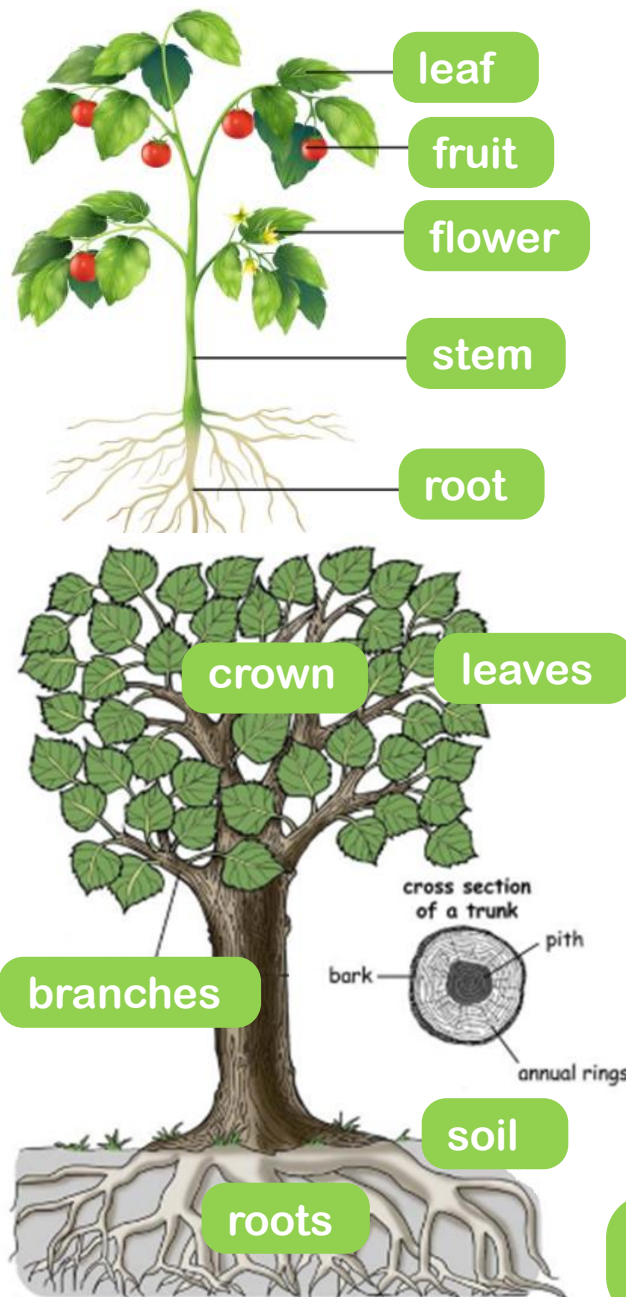


Year 1 – Plants

Key Word	Meaning
plant	A living thing that has a seed, root, stem and leaves
seed	The start of a plant
root	The part of a plant that grows down into the soil to get water and food
stem	The part of a plant that grows above the soil. The leaves and flowers grow from it
blossom	Another word for flower. It is the part of the plant where seeds are made
trunk	The part of a tree that grows above the soil. The leaves and flowers grow from it
deciduous	It describes a group of plants that drops its leaves in the Autumn and grows new leaves in the Spring
evergreen	It describes a group of plants that keeps most of its leaves all year, dropping a few at a time
crop	A plant that is grown for sale
harvest	To bring in a crop, ready to use
