Cost of Living Support


We know that people are worried about rising costs and may be struggling. The Essex Family Wellbeing Team have pulled together a document which you may find helpful.

You've helped to raise £9200 – thank you for your support this term!

It's been a fantastic start to our fundraising year this term and we've loved sharing some of our best-loved events with the school community, including our Winter Fayres extravaganza, Christmas Presents for Parents plus all those gorgeous printed Christmas cards and gifts designed by your talented children!

We've also held uniform sales and a textile collection this term. And not forgetting Kelly's £1000 prize draw win and the extra pennies that trickle in from our easyfundraisers. It all adds up. With your generous support, we've raised around £9200 for the school – an incredible amount that every cake baker and ticket buyer and raffle donor and Christmas card giver and fayre goer and hands on volunteer and 100 clubber and easyfundraiser has helped us make. Thank you!

We've been able to invest in the school too: this term we're funding a project to install a brilliant new Trim Trail in the playground (£7k) plus an anti-bullying workshop in school (£870) as well as an enhanced poetry selection (£100) to support the current curriculum. We've also given each year group £100 to be able to choose smaller ways to make a difference to their learning environments.

We will have our Children's Consultation kicking off next term in which we will ask all pupils to suggest ideas for things we can help to fund, from better footballs at break time to ways to make their classrooms even better or visits to places that can bring their learning alive.

There's lots more fun to come in the Spring with school discos to look out for along with the annual RAB PTA Quiz Night!
