Year 5 spent the day back in in 1940 Britain where the children had been evacuated to a rural village school. They spent the morning in lessons, learning the importance of gas mask safety and what to do in



an air raid. The children also completed a maths lesson where they learnt how to convert farthings, shillings, pence and pounds. During the afternoon, lessons were cancelled and they spent the afternoon shopping and working in shops and cafes, using their ration books and new knowledge of the coins to buy all they needed. However they had to be careful, as there were police around fining them if they did not have the appropriate documents! A great way to bring their current topic to life.
