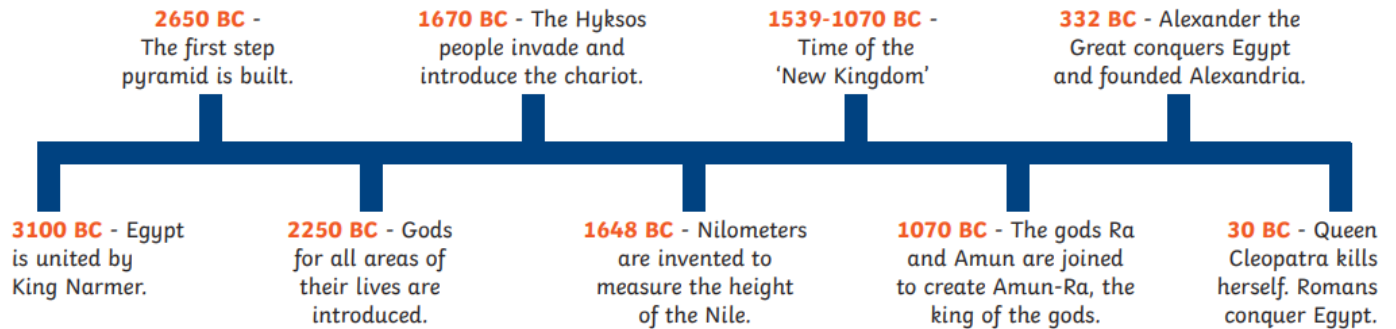




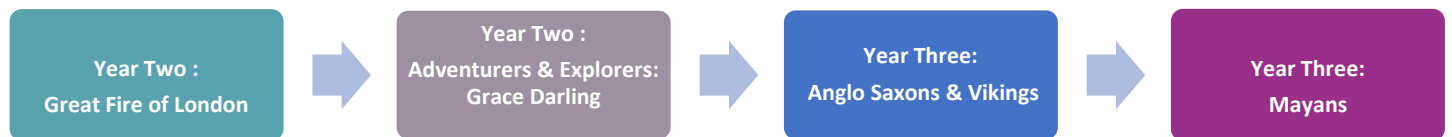

Word	Definition
ancient	The word used to describe people and places that belonged to the very distant past and are no longer in existence
pharaoh	An Ancient Egyptian ruler (King or Queen)
artefact	An object from the past that shows evidence of what has been
hierarchy	The social groups within a society
settlement	A place where people settle and live
civilisation	The society, culture and way of life of a particular area
hieroglyphics	A picture used instead of writing to represent letters or words
evidence	Facts or information about events
archaeology	The study of human history and prehistory through the excavation of sites and the study of artefacts and other physical remains
archaeologist	The person who studies human history and prehistory through looking at artefacts and other physical remains
excavation	The act of removing earth that is covering very old objects buried in the ground in order to discover things about the past
