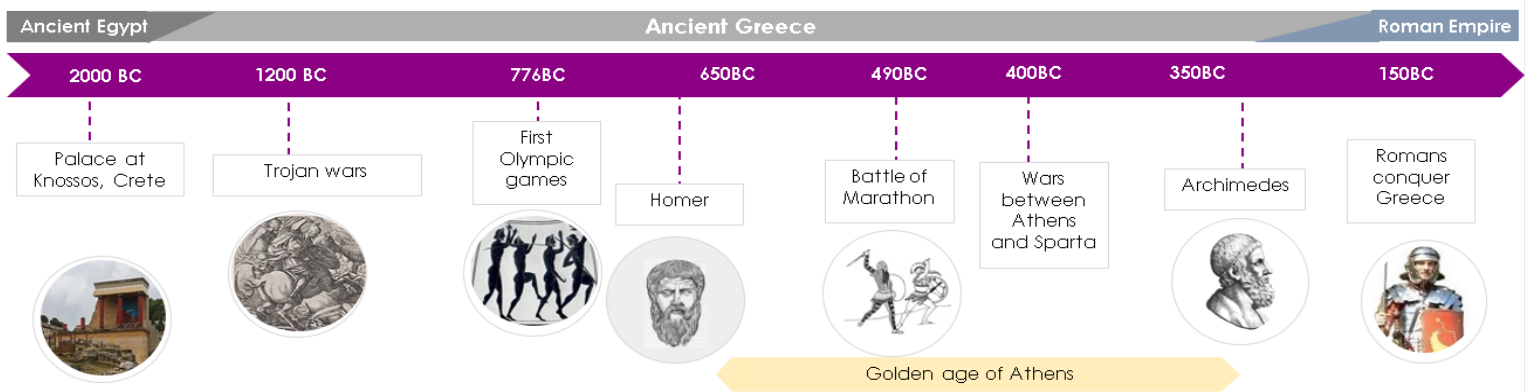


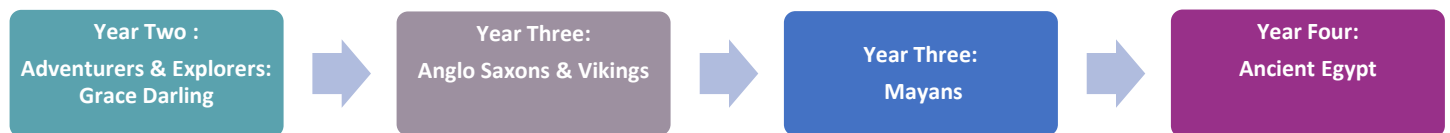

Key Vocabulary

Word	Definition
Alliance	A relationship of support formed of mutual benefit or interest. Countries which have an alliance will help each other out.
City-States	Groups of villages that banded together to protect one another. Each had its own government and army.
Democracy	All adult men had a say in how the state was run. They voted at the assembly. The majority ruled.
Assembly	A regular opportunity for all male citizens of Athens to speak their minds and exercise their votes regarding the government of their city.
Republic	A country in which power is held by the people and their elected representatives. The president is elected by the people.
Citizens	An inhabitant of a town or city.
