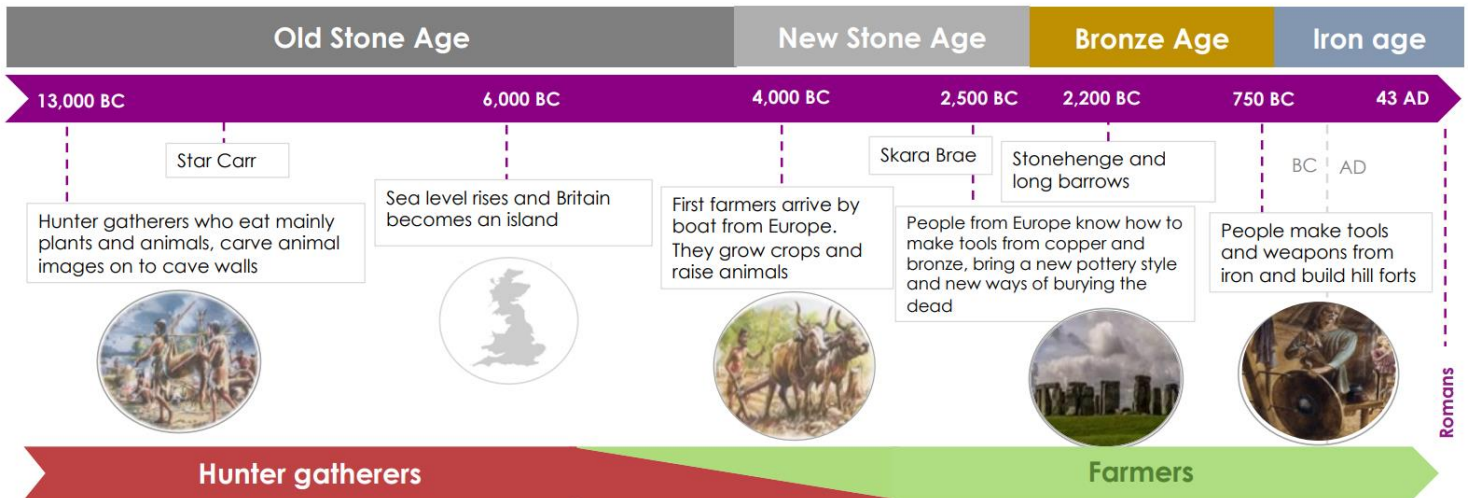


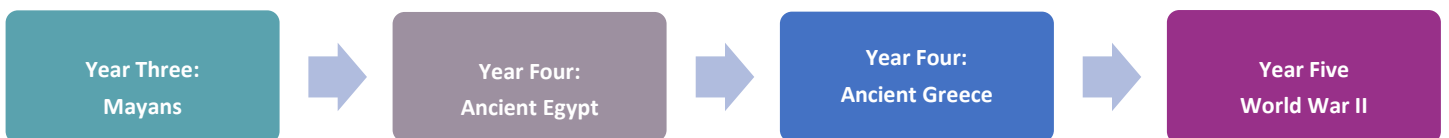

Word	Definition
Homo Sapiens	The species to which all modern human beings belong
Hunter gatherer	People who live by hunting, fishing, and harvesting wild food
Nomads.	People that travel and have no permanent home
Settlement	A permanent place to live
Tribe	A group of people of the same culture
Agriculture	The practice of growing crops or raising animals
Society	People living together in an ordered community
Paleolithic	The early phase of the Stone Age. It lasted for 2.5 million years and man used primitive stone tools
Neolithic	The “new Stone Age”. The Neolithic Period began about 10,000 years ago. During this period people ground and polished stone to make more useful tools. They also learned to grow crops and to tame animals.
Primitive	Very basic or unsophisticated
