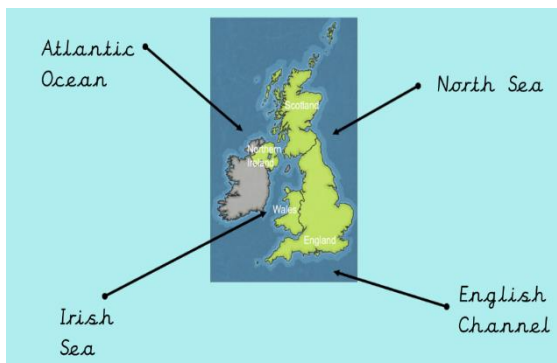
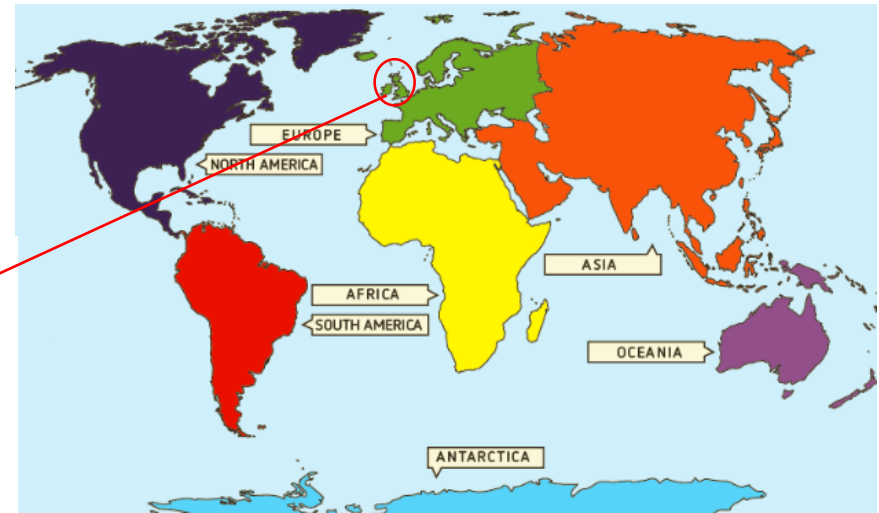
2. ocean or sea
